



## Kitten Feeding Schedule (Birth – 4 Weeks)

Use this schedule as a guideline for bottle-feeding orphaned or nursing-support kittens. Feed with kitten milk replacer (KMR) only. Adjust amounts based on weight gain and stool quality.

Age	Weight Range	Per Feeding	Feedings / Day	Notes
0–1 week	2–4 oz (60–120 g)	5–10 mL	6–8x	Keep warm; stimulate elimination
1–2 weeks	4–8 oz (120–230 g)	10–15 mL	6–8x	Weigh daily (+10–15 g/day)
2–3 weeks	8–12 oz (230–340 g)	15–25 mL	5–6x	Introduce gentle handling
3–4 weeks	12–16 oz (340–450 g)	25–40 mL	4–5x	Begin weaning with gruel

### ***Tips***

- Feed kittens belly-down; never on their backs.
- Warm formula in a water bath—never microwave.
- Sanitize bottles and nipples between feeds.
- If kitten is cold, warm first, then feed.
